

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENT SCHEDULED FOR SURGERY AND/OR TREATMENT  
UNDER INTRAVENOUS OR ORAL SEDATION

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

1. If you are taking Halcion (oral sedation) medication needs to be taken one hour before appointment. Do not take pain medicine before surgery.
2. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK anything 6 hours prior to surgery, unless otherwise instructed. Do take your regular medications at the time you normally take them, use little water when taking such medications
3. A responsible adult MUST ACCOMPANY you to the office, REMAIN in the reception room during the procedure, STAY with you and monitor you for 24 hours after surgery.
4. Wear loose old clothing with SHORT SLEEVES, so that we can place IV and monitor your blood pressure and pulse
5. If you develop a cold or any physical illness before your appointment, be sure to call and notify us, it may be necessary to postpone your appointment in order to achieve proper sedation.
